

Employment

(1) Conditions for Being Employed

In order to be employed in Japan, the following working status must be obtained.

- Japanese Spouse
- Long term Resident (up until third-generation Japanese)
- Permanent Resident
- Spouse of a Permanent Resident

(2) Work Placement

In order to seek a job in Japan, you can receive work placement (free service) from the Public Employment Security Office or get information on jobs through the magazines with the want ads sold in bookstores or convenience stores.

(3) Activities not Permitted under the Status of Residence and Part-time Jobs

A foreign student must make an application to engage in activities not permitted under the status of residence with the Immigration Bureau in order to work a part-time job.

Items Necessary for Application

- Application to engage in activities not permitted under status of residence (form supplied at the Fukuoka Immigration Bureau Naha Branch)
- letter of reason (State purpose and content)
- student registration certificate
- passport
- Alien Registration Certificate
